About the Program

This program is for low-income seniors age 55 and over with medication expenses that are not covered by health insurance or any other program. Agency staff screen for available free medications for seniors from drug companies.

Drug companies that offer free medications require income and health information.

The result of the screening, along with each drug company form, is mailed to the prescribing doctor for signature.

It is the senior's responsibility to notify the Pharmacy Connection Program staff when medications are received and when refills are needed.

Medications are usually sent to the prescribing doctor's office, but sometimes are sent to the senior's home.

How to Apply
